

NEW D.A.P.® Collar

NEW D.A.P. Collar helps comforts puppies and adult dogs in situations they may find worrying or which makes them apprehensive. The collar stays on the dog at all times and helps with events both inside and outside the home including:

- Adjusting to a new environment (puppies, rescue dogs, dogs in kennels)
- A puppy's socialisation period
- · Novel and unpredictable situation away from the home
- Fear related reactions expressed outside the home (traffic, other dogs, thunderstorms, gunshots etc.)

The D.A.P.* Collar works by releasing a constant stream of synthetic dog appeasing pheromone for a period of about 4 weeks. The dog appeasing pheromone is a substance produced naturally by a lactating bitch to reassure and calm her puppies, as they explore and learn about the world around them.

Importantly this pheromone is also proven to have a positive relaxing and comforting influence on adult dogs, increasing their confidence in the outside world and make the process of accepting new or difficult stimuli more relaxed and less challenging.

How to use D.A.P. Collar

- Fasten the collar around the dog's neck and adjust
- Cut off the excess portion of the collar
- Leave the collar around the dog's neck at all times
- The effect of the collar lasts for up to 4 weeks



Combining D.A.P.* Collar with D.A.P.* Diffuser may provide optimum results for dogs showing indoor and outdoor fears and for puppies or adult dogs settling into a new home. In multi-dog households, it is recommended that all the dogs wear a D.A.P.* Collar or that a D.A.P.* Diffuser is plugged in.
